4	(a) In General.—The Secretary of Transportation
5	shall make permanent the exemption relating to pre-trip
6	vehicle inspection skills test requirements for certain
7	school bus drivers, as published in the Federal Register
8	on December 2, 2024 (89 Fed. Reg. 95348), including the
9	terms and conditions of the exemption described in para-

12	(b) Reporting.—For the 6-year period beginning on
13	the date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Trans-
14	portation shall require any State that participates in the

17	ing the number of drivers that obtain a commercial driv-
18	ers' license under such exemption in the State.
